



## MASAI MARA MIGRATION SAFARI

### *A Tailor-Made African Adventure with Safari Lodges & Select Tented Camps*

#### **Day 1 –September 09, 2019– Arrival Nairobi**

Arrive in Nairobi, Kenya where a Wildlife Safari representative will meet you and after immigration and customs, escort you to the Eka Hotel and conduct a welcome safari briefing. The hotel is within convenient access to all the city's tourist attractions such as; Nairobi National Park, Karen Blixen Museum, The National Museum, Bomas of Kenya and The Giraffe Centre. Spend the rest of the day is at leisure at your hotel.

#### **Day 2 – September 10, 2019 – Amboseli**

Breakfast at the Hotel and depart for Amboseli National Park arriving at your Lodge in time for lunch. Amboseli Serena Lodge is built in the architectural style of a Masai “manyatta” or village with bold colours and local artefacts. It overlooks the savannah plains with uninterrupted views of Africa’s highest peak, Mt. Kilimanjaro. As you set off on your afternoon game viewing drive in the sanctuary Mount Kilimanjaro provides a dramatic backdrop to the Amboseli. You will be invited to plant an acacia tree as part of “The Amboseli Reforestation” project started by Wildlife Safari & Serena Hotels and receive a special certificate.

### **Day 3 –September 11, 2019 – Amboseli**

Dawn is the best time for game viewing in Amboseli with the possibility of a clear view of Mount Kilimanjaro's snow covered summit. Return to your lodge for a late breakfast and spend the rest of the morning relaxing by the swimming pool. Amboseli National Park is famous for being the best place in Africa to get close to free-ranging elephants among other wildlife species. With its awesome view of Mount Kilimanjaro (Africa's highest mountain at 5,895m), Amboseli National Park offers a unique and breathtaking backdrop for viewing Africa's animals. Kenya birds, both large and small are in abundance. The park has a dry lake basin that houses a temporary lake, Lake Amboseli, after the rains. There are emerald green swamps that are fed by the melting snows of Mt. Kilimanjaro. Visit the prehistoric site of the Observation Hill and get to see the magnificent sunset over Kilimanjaro as well as an overall view of the whole park. Another game viewing drive late this afternoon possibly around the many lakes and springs fed by Kilimanjaro's melting snows. Return to your lodge for a special "boma" dinner under Kilimanjaro and a multitude of stars.

### **Day 4 – September 12, 2019– Ol Pejeta**

Depart after breakfast and drive to Ol Pejeta Ranch with your final destination being Sweetwater's Camp. The Camp offers quality luxurious tented accommodation and overlooks a large watering hole backed by a spectacular view of Mount Kenya, a lovely swimming pool and a game viewing bar. Lunch at the Camp followed by an afternoon game viewing drive through the sanctuary returning to the lodge for dinner.

### **Day 5-September 13, 2019 – Ol Pejeta**

Full day spent at the Sweetwater's game sanctuary. All your meals will be served at the Camp. **Ol Pejeta Conservancy** is a non-profit organization situated between the foot hills of the Aberdares and Mount Kenya. The conservancy encompasses the Sweetwater's Chimpanzee Sanctuary where the chimpanzees are located and the old surrounding ranches which have been reverted to wilderness. The Conservancy works to conserve wildlife, provide protection for great apes and to generate income through wildlife tourism and complementary enterprises for re-investment in conservation and community development. The conservancy has an extensive variety of animals including the big five as well as a chimpanzee sanctuary. It boasts the largest black rhino sanctuary in East Africa. The Chimpanzee Sanctuary provides a haven for orphaned, abandoned and rescued chimpanzee and is the only place in Kenya that you will get to see the Chimpanzees living naturally within their dedicated habitat. Being a private sanctuary, the Ranch allows walking, riding safaris and night game drives.

### **Day 6-14 September, 2019 – Lake Nakuru**

Morning breakfast then drive to Lake Nakuru National Park. Arrive at Lake Nakuru Lodge in time for lunch. In the afternoon proceed for the evening game viewing drive returning to the lodge late in



the evening. The name Nakuru means "Dust or Dusty Place" in the Maasai language. Lake Nakuru is protected under the Ramsar Site Convention as a wetland area and is best known for its thousands, sometimes millions of flamingos nesting along the shores. Other bird species include pelicans, cormorants, herons, the African fish eagles, grebes, stilts, avocets, and duck among others. The park is a breeding sanctuary for rhinos and has one of the largest concentrations in the country of both black and white rhinos. There are also a number of Rothschild's giraffe, translocated for safety from western Kenya. Waterbuck are very common and both Kenyan species are found here. Among the predators are lion, cheetah and leopard, the latter being seen much more frequently in recent times.

**Overnights – Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge**

#### **Day 7-15 September, 2019 – Masai Mara**

Breakfast and depart for Masai Mara Game Reserve where almost immediately, you are surrounded by wildlife as you game view on the vast savannah grasslands as you drive towards your safari Camp. Arrival in time for lunch. Mara Intrepids Club is located at the centre of the Mara Triangle. Sitting on the bend of Talek River, the Camp has one of the most spectacular locations in Mara ecosystems. The camp combines luxurious accommodation with fine dining and warm hospitality. At Mara Intrepids Tented Camp, every effort is made to make guests feel comfortable by providing the best in services and amenities. The ambiance of Mara Intrepids Tented Camp is reflected in every guestroom. The camp offers fantastic facilities, including massage, garden, outdoor pool, games room, kids club, to help you unwind after a long day. . In the afternoon, proceed for a game viewing drive in this part of the Masai Mara ecosystem before returning to your lodge for dinner and overnight

**Overnight – Mara Intrepids Club**

#### **Day 8/10 – 16+17+18 –September 2019 – Masai Mara**

Spend three full days of game viewing in the Masai Mara following wildebeest, zebra, gazelle, eland, topi, impala and other plains species. The big cats, lion, leopard and cheetah are found in greater concentrations than anywhere else and looking to pounce, if the opportunity arises. Herds of giraffe and elephant create a magical silhouette against the treeless savannah while hippo and crocodile happily frolic in the Mara and Talek rivers.

***PS: Your Wildlife Safari guide may suggest an extended game viewing drive, travelling much further away from other vehicles and visitors, with a special picnic lunch from your safari lodge.***

**Overnight – Mara Intrepids Club**

#### **Day 11 -19 September, 2019– Nairobi**

Breakfast at the Camp before driving to the airstrip for your morning flight to Nairobi. Your Wildlife Safari Tour Manager will meet and escort you to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport where you have a day room at the Four Points Sheraton before checking in and boarding your flight back home.
